

Researching Out of Province Universities

1. Go to www.schoolfinder.com (School Finder website)
2. Type in the program you are interested in, and you will get a list of schools that have the program available
3. Highlight a school you would like more information on. Go to the website.
4. Go to **Admission Requirements** and find out which pre-requisites are required for your program. **Make sure you find the requirements for Ontario students**
5. Follow the same steps as outlined in researching Ontario universities.

6. Use the **Program Details** chart to keep track of information
7. Sign out University calendars in Student Services.
